Structural Burn Building Facilitator

We are increasing our pool of **Structural Burn Building Facilitators** for the Fire School.

The Facilitator's role shall be:

1. Assume a role of stewardship of the Fire School, keeping the facilities safe, intact and ready for the next use.
2. Provide facility support for live fire training exercises.

*This position **IS NOT** to be considered as an adjunct instructor or to have any role in the direct training of participants in Live Fire Training Exercises conducted at YCFS*

*This is a **compensated position** and successful candidates will be paid on a **per diem** basis as determined by the Live Fire Training Exercises Facilitated.*

Candidates for the Position of YCFS Structural Burn Building Facilitator shall complete and submit an application for the position and must possess the following qualifications:

(Copies of certification and Drivers License must accompany application)

Completion Certificates for EBM, ELIF or Firefighter I certification or their equivalent

(As determined by the Board of Governors of the Fire Chiefs' and Firefighters' Association of York County)

Valid Driver's License (issued by current state of residence)

A letter of recommendation from a Chief or Senior Fire Service Official attesting to candidate's character and ability to take responsibility for oversight of the process

Candidates who are selected must complete an Orientation Class, apply for approved driver status at the Fire School and submit all pertinent information for the completion of required payroll forms

Please return completed application and necessary documentation prior to the orientation class.
