Monthly Meeting Minutes

October 17, 2016

CALL TO ORDER (President Chad Deardorff)

President Chad Deardorff called the monthly meeting of the York County Fire Chiefs and Firefighters Association to order at 19:01. The call to order was followed by a pledge to the flag and a moment of silence. 50+ people, including members of the EMS Association were in attendance.

Clif Laughman of WMTFD welcomed the Association to their station. President Deardorff thanked the fire company for their hospitality and the meal.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

President Deardorff asked if there were any corrections to last month's minutes. With no corrections, the minutes were approved as issued.

REPORTS

<u>Treasurer</u> (Bob Bowman):

Treasurer Bob Bowman presented the following report: Beginning Balance: \$12,526.76 with an Ending Balance: \$16,991.46. With no comments, President Deardorff approved the Treasurer's Report as read.

Board of Governors (**John Senft):** The Board met this evening prior to this meeting and discussed the following:

Financial statements / cash flow / month-by-month accounting period change / financial payment procedures & audit / 2017 fire school schedule on website / \$389,175 of Association funds approved for the RACP project.

Fire School Administrator (Richard Halpin):

September Fire School Training: 263 hours / 116 for fire school classes.

Firefighter 1 testing will be October 6th and 7th, 2017.

Heather will be on maternity leave this Fall.

If you have any outstanding fees to pay, please do so for year-end closeout.

The total construction cost for the RACP capital projects is \$1,444,000. The Association's share is \$389,175. The new buildings should be coming out of the ground in mid-November and be complete the end of February.

911 Center/YCDES (Nick Coby):

911 is continuing to work with Tyler Technologies on the CAD upgrade.

The Can-you-hear-me-now testing is continuing.

The EMS mobile radio installs will start next month.

PA State Police (Brad Dunham):

The specs for brush unit designation will be brought up under New Business for approval.

ATR (John Sanford):

The ATR team had 4 calls for the month; 51 calls for the year.

Haz-Mat (Ray Kinsey):

The Haz-Mat team had 3 calls for the month; 44 calls for the year.

Fire Police (Jim Robertson):

38 members from 22 companies and 7 guests were at the last meeting. Elections are coming up.

Joe Hammers reported on meetings to create an 8 county fire police task force with common SOGs to support each other on large incidents. The SOGs are being developed and will be sent out. Joe suggested creating a York County Fire Police Task Force, ideally with North and South units with traffic unit support. Contact Joe if your company has any interest in being on the task force.

NEW BUSINESS:

President Deardorff asked for volunteers to serve on a Nominating Committee. Clif Laughman, Tim Mooney, and Brian Widmayer agreed to be on the committee. Richard will create a Nominating Committee email group to solicit interest.

Brad Dunham made a motion to approve the brush unit designation with the following unit requirements. Larry Crouse seconded the motion and the motion carried

4 x 4 chassis

Maximum GVWR: 19,500 lbs

• Pump: ≥ 100 gpm

• Water Tank: ≥ 150 gallons

• Minimum of two discharges (at least one 1" or larger)

Minimum of 400' of 1" hose

Minimum of two (2) Indian style tanks (metal or soft side bladder)

Minimum of two (2) forestry rakes

• UTV/ATV do not get brush designation

A presentation for a new proposed P25 radio fleet map (attached to minutes) was given by Scott Keener from the 911 center. It proposes splitting Fire and EMS into 2 separate banks and consolidating the existing 4 regional zones into 2 zones identified as North and South split roughly by Route 30. The proposal was supported and demonstrated with historical call volumes for each emergency service and zone. Brad Dunham made a motion to proceed with the proposal with the understanding that if within 1 year of it being implemented that if it is found to be not working, it be revisited. Harold Wertz seconded the motion and the motion carried. Chad Deardorff requested that any questions on the fleet map be directed to the radio committee.

REMARKS FOR THE GOOD OF THE ASSOCIATION:

Joe Madzelan proposed having joint Fire and EMS association meetings once a year.

The next meeting will be November 21, 2016 at 19:00 at the Fire School.
