- Final architect/engineer walk-thru is April 19th
- Traffic coating will be installed on the drill tower floor next week
- Two ladder anchors are still needed
- The parking lot is being done this week
- The rain garden is in
- The new burn building stair is being used
- Spalled concrete is under investigation. No burning is permitted in the affected rooms.

OTHER AGENCY REPORTS

911 Center/YCDES (Nick Coby):

The radio project is moving forward. PD's radios are in progress for new equipment.

Audio issues have been dealt with re: hardware patch.

They are ahead schedule for mobile installs. Fire installs will probably start in mid-May to June.

PA State Police (Brad Dunham):

Not present. Others reported the grant money is used up. Carberry is retiring. New guys need training so Dunham is kind of on his own.

ATR (John Sanford):

The ATR team had 3 calls for the month; 6 calls for the year.
