LINE OFFICER OF THE YEAR AWARD APPLICATION

Purpose: To recognize the outstanding achievements of a Line Officer who demonstrates distinguished accomplishments in citizenship, leadership and professionalism in the emergency services community.

Requirements:

- 1.) Must be 19 years of age or older at time of application.
- 2.) Must be an active member within a York County fire or EMS station.
- 3.) Only one candidate per organization.
- 4.) Candidate need not be a member of the Firefighters Association of York County.
- 5.) This recognition is only awarded once.
- 6.) Letter of endorsement from organization with membership's approval. This is to be no more than two pages, single spaced, 12 point font.

Judging Overall Criteria:

- 1.) Exemplifies the virtues of professionalism and dedication to the emergency services through training, response and leadership.
- 2.) Has demonstrated personal sacrifice in time and effort, exceeding his/her capabilities to achieve the overall mission and vision of the emergency services.
- 3.) Exhibits professional leadership qualities of the organization during station activities and incident activities.
- 4.) Demonstrates a distinct pattern of community service through non-emergency service work, public education and other civic / religious / fraternal organizational work that directly or indirectly benefits the emergency services.
- 5.) Evidence submitted must have been attained between August 1, 2018 and June 30, 2019.

Judging Specific Criteria:

For the following, a nominating member must attest, in writing with specifics as possible, to items 1 through 6 and must have been accomplished between 8/1/18 and 6/30/19:

- 1.) How many emergency response calls responded to? What percentage of total calls does this equate to?
- 2.) How many regular company meetings were attended?
- 3.) How many committees did the candidate serve on? How many did they chair?
- 4.) How many hours of training/certification classes did the candidate complete from an educational training agency, such as HACC, EMI or TrainPA? This shall include training that is required to be an organizational officer. **(Copies of certificates required.)**
- 5.) How many hours of in-house training did the candidate complete? How many were led by this candidate?
- 6.) How many work details / public education / non-emergency events did the candidate actively participate in? How many of these were organized or overseen by the candidate?
- 7.) Demonstration of recognition by awards, news clippings or letters of commendation that recognized the remarkable attributes of this candidate? This may be emergency services, civic, fraternal or religious organization related. **(Limit to five (5)).**

NOTE: Applications will be rejected if the application incomplete upon receipt. The Committee will not reach out asking for items that are missing or incomplete.
