**Equipment Recommended:** Dry Suit/Layering, Water Rescue Helmet, PFD, Foot Protection, Gloves, Eye Protection and Change of Dry Clothes. **\*NOTE\*** Recommend 2-3 students per inflatable rescue boat, 4 students per hard bottom rescue boat, must supply your own boat.
