If at all possible, try to keep as much as possible for the investigation, not just for the fire marshal but also for the insurance private fire investigator. The investigator talked about how a private investigator can support the process for the local municipality when they don't have the funding or resources.

Jon reports that the NYCRPD announced that their new facility will have some of the items that we spoke about for our new building, and that will take care of some of the items that we needed to address. No further update.

#### **UNFINISHED BUSINESS:**

Proposal for policy change for response checks and replacement equipment on non-working incidents (i.e. fire alarms)

Tabled

Incident Support Team (IST) survey results and updates

Joe Madzelan reports that they established an executive board to establish policies and the general operations. Still working on preferred training and the process of applying and such. Still months away from having anything ready, but still progressing. There was s question about workers comp. The county can cover if there is an issue since it will be a county team.

#### **NEW BUSINESS:**

Captain 89 (Jerry Stroble), spoke about how maydays are handled in the county. He spoke about some concerns that were found at the county level. Did a lot of his research through Project MayDay, which reviewed 10,000 maydays.

Some questions / thoughts about the county policy 1) When a mayday is called, the county will move all units except the mayday units to another channel – what units are switched? 2) How much can an incident commander handle during a mayday. 3) Typically career maydays are mostly at night and volunteer are mostly during the day. 4) County policy states that the units not involved will be changed to the emergency channel – what units are being moved? 5) Suggestion is to follow a PD signal 13 event and the dispatcher will announce that all units to hold all non-mayday traffic. 6) Suggested that the incident commander makes the determination of who and when units move if needed. 7) Continue with the dispatcher dispatching the MayDay assignment and have them to another channel so the dispatcher can give the appropriate additional information. 7) Also, have the dispatcher reserve an additional talk

group to be used as needed.

Lots of discussion amongst the group. Chad recommended that the group put the suggested changes into a policy change and bring it back to the association for more discussion. Chief 9 (Chris) asked if we can set up two talk groups on structure fires, using 2 at a time. Add it into the policy for discussion.
